Addressing trauma- and evidence-informed instruction and the importance of social-emotional well-being in the classroom, this training, which is part of the online course, meets the Special Education and Behavioral Health Licensure Renewal Requirements for Colorado educators "seeking to renew any teacher, special service provider, principal and/or administrator professional license that expires on or after June 30, 2025."
